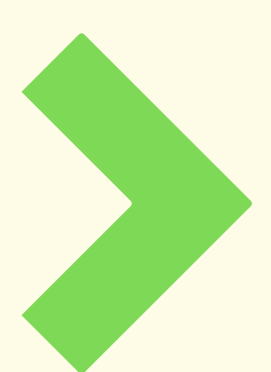

## GUIDELINES FOR ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

**PLEASE NOTE - Registration for ICACON 2023 is a prerequisite for any presentation Category of Presentation - Platform Paper/ E- Poster Presentation.**

- The abstract must be original and should not have been presented or published elsewhere.
- The abstract should be submitted online to [icabangalore2023@gmail.com](mailto:icabangalore2023@gmail.com).
- Please mention your designation (Postgraduate student/ Consultant) and category of presentation (Paper / E-poster)
- The last date for abstract submission is 15th October 2023
- All the abstracts will be reviewed by the reviewer committee
- Notification of submission will be sent to the corresponding author and the acceptance will be communicated via mail after the review/revision process
- The result for acceptance of submission will be announced by 20th October 2023
- The final decision of allowing the presentation of your choice or change in category or rejection will remain as per the discretion of the Review Committee and Scientific Committee.
- Those selected should upload their presentation by 25th October 2023.

### GUIDELINES FOR ABSTRACT SUBMISSION:

- Abstract for clinical studies should be structured under headings - Introduction, Methods, Results, Conclusion and references with a maximum word count of 300 words.
- Abstract for Case report/case series should be unstructured with a maximum word count of 250 words.
- Kindly note the word count excludes references.

- a) One delegate can submit 2 abstracts of different kind.
- b) A maximum of 1+3 authors are allowed for each abstract.
- c) It is mandatory that the first (main) author should be the presenting author and will be the recipient of the award.
- d) The presenting author is required to ensure that all co-authors are aware of the contents of the abstract before submission
- e) The presenting author's name must be highlighted and the presenting author's full name, institution, address for communication, phone number and email address must be provided. Email address and Mobile number is mandatory as all further communications will be done via email

### Guidelines for Presentation

Kindly note that your timings will be 6+2 minutes for the Paper presentation and 4+2 minutes for E-poster presentation respectively.

#### A) RESEARCH PAPER

- The title slide should have Indian College of Anaesthesiologists logo and your institutional logo. The title of the study and the names of all authors should also be included.
- Presentation must include the major headings - Introduction, Methods, Statistical Analysis, Results, Discussion, Conclusion, and References.
- Introduction - Mention the need for study, aims, and objectives.
- Methods - Mention the type and design of the study, ethics clearance, clinical trial registration number if any, inclusion and exclusion criteria, blinding, randomization, sample size estimation, methodology, and statistical details.
- Results - Details of demographics, primary and secondary outcome measures.
- Discussion - Comparison with previous literature, limitations, and future scope
- Conclusion - to be precise and focussed on the primary aim of the study.
- References: only pertinent references (best 2) to be added.

#### B) CASE REPORT

- New interesting and rare cases can be reported. They should be unique, describing a great diagnostic or therapeutic challenge and providing a learning point for the readers. Cases with clinical significance or implications will be given priority. These should have the following headings: Introduction, Case report, Discussion and References
